* 2014 GCSE results are not comparable with results from previous years, both the way in which the whole school results are calculated and the manner in which the students were assessed are different.

The number of marks required to gain a grade C and above was raised and the number of students achieving A/A* has dropped nationally. The national figure for the number of students gaining 5A*-C including English and Maths in 2013 was 59%, in 2014 it is 53%.

Maths results have been affected in a number of ways. It is agreed nationally that the examination contained more challenging questions; a higher number of marks was required to pass each grade and in previous years students were able to sit the exam in November and resit in June if they did not achieve a grade C the first time. The November entry exam has been removed and the new reporting rules mean that only the first grade a student is given counts for the school results.
