DEAR 30 MINUTES EVERY DAY					

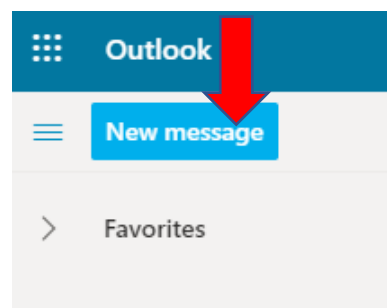
On each weekday morning between **8am – 9am** you will receive an email from a teacher in each subject you have on that day.

e.g. on Monday Year 7s will get an email from English, Science and History; Year 10 will get an email from English and Science, as well as Computer Science, French, Dance or Sport if you take that Options subject.

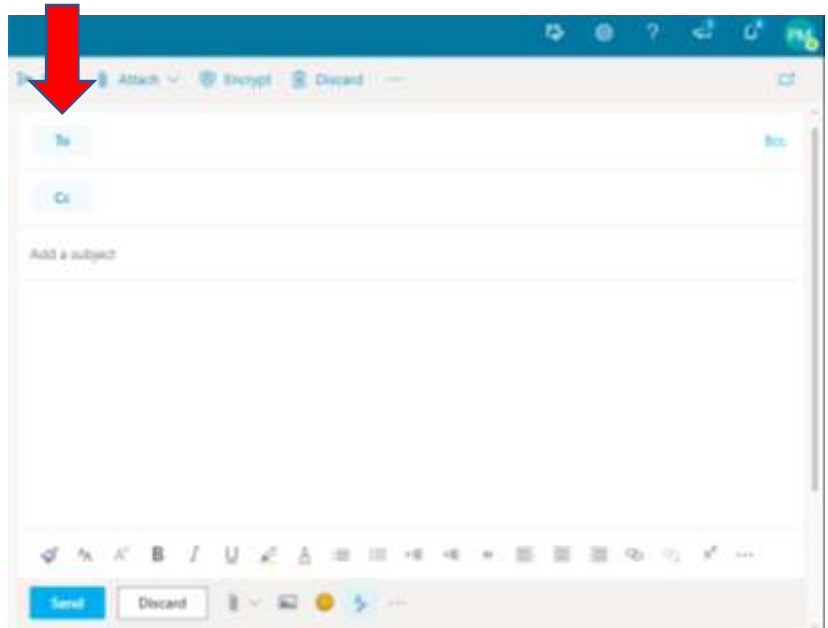
We are designing the work carefully for you to be able to complete it at home independently, however we know that at times you may need extra support. Here is a checklist to run through when this happens:

1. *Have you reread the instructions for the task? Can you rephrase the task to yourself to help?*
2. *If there are any words or ideas that you are confused about you should try a Google search or use Dictionary.com.*
3. *Is there a classmate you can contact to talk through the work with? Talking through something can help make it clear.*
4. *Is there someone at home you can talk the work through with? This could be an adult or another young person. They don't need to be an expert 😊*

6. *If you are still stuck after the steps above, you can email your class teacher for that subject. Log in to your school email address at <https://outlook.live.com/owa/>:*

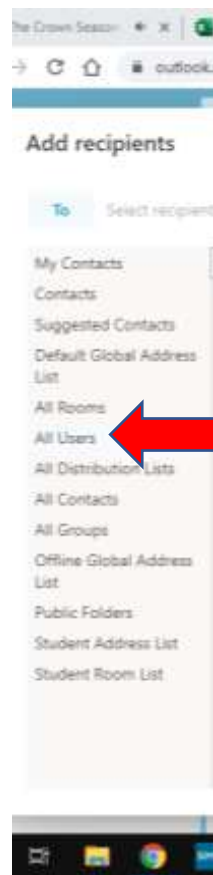
a) Select 'New message'



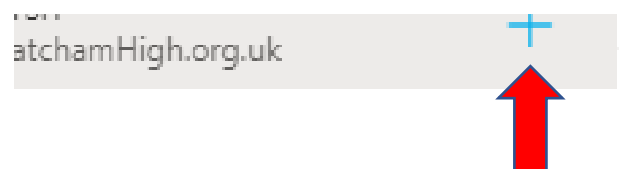
b) Click on 'To'
