

## COVID 19 Home/School agreement



### The School will:

- Ask Staff with symptoms not to come to school. Anyone who starts to display symptoms during the day will be isolated and then sent home
- Ask staff to wash their hands regularly throughout the day, specifically when entering and exiting the school building or a room within the school building
- Ensure all rooms have sanitiser or a sink and soap
- Ensure all rooms have tissues, bins and NHS signage to reinforce the NHS message catch it, bin it, kill it
- Ensure that all areas of the school are regularly and systemically cleaned
- Set up Year group 'bubbles' in zones around the school to minimise contact
- Whenever possible, set classrooms up with pupils sitting side-by-side and facing forward
- Ensure that staff maintain a distance from pupils and other staff
- Ensure pupils social distance (1 metre plus) during breaks, lunches, and transitions
- Ensure no areas of the school become crowded
- Ensure the school building is well ventilated
- Alert the local health prevention team immediately if a case is suspected

### The Parent/Carer will:

- Ensure my child comes back to school in September if they are well
- Encourage my child to come straight to and go straight home from school
- Keep my child at home should they display any symptoms of Covid 19
- Notify the school of any suspected cases of Covid 19 at home
- Notify the school of any positive testing for Covid 19 in the family
- Allow the school to carry out any necessary health screening
- Collect my child from school within 30 minutes if they become unwell
- Collect my child from school within 30 minutes if they fail to comply with the Covid 19 Home/School agreement
- Not enter the school building without an appointment
- Support the school with any behaviour issues

### The Student will:

- Follow social distancing guidelines on journeys to and from school
- Arrive on time to their dedicated entrance
- Use the hand sanitiser on arrival
- Avoiding touching unnecessary surfaces
- Follow the social distancing rules and one-way systems that the school has put in place
- Stay in the designated area for their year group and not attempt to move into another year group's area
- Abide by new timings for break and lunch
- Follow all instructions which are there to keep them and others safe including those both in and outside of classrooms
- Wash their hands after going to the toilet and regularly throughout the day for at least 20 seconds using soap
- Sneeze and cough into a tissue (which is thrown away immediately) or into their elbow
- If arriving on public transport place their mask in a plastic bag and into their school bag for use on the journey home
- Tell a member of staff if they feel unwell
- Not make any jokes about Covid 19 or deliberately cough or sneeze near another person.
- Respect the seriousness of the Covid 19 pandemic at all times
- Accept that things have to be different for now, but we will work as a team to get through it

**Parents/Carers are expected to adhere to the home/school agreement by default. Any parent who does not agree to abide by the home/school agreement needs to say so in writing directly to the headteacher.**
