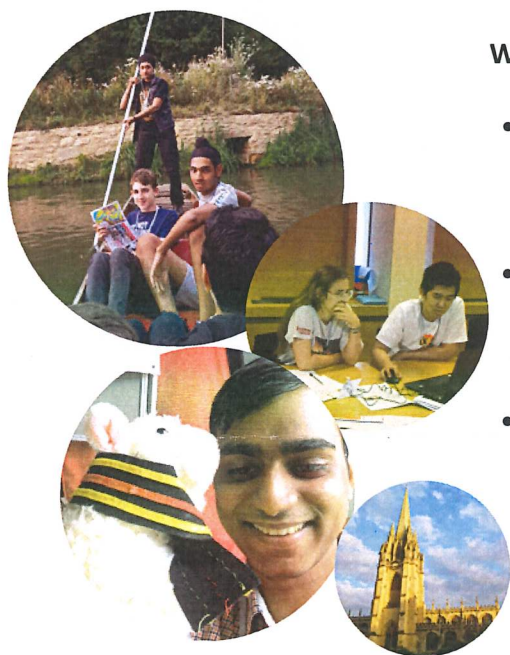
### WHAT YOU'LL GET
