



TEACHING & LEARNING ASSISTANT /Individual Needs Assistant - D GRADE – Fixed Term Contract

We are looking to appoint a D Grade innovative Teaching & Learning Assistant/INA (Individual Needs Assistant) to undertake a varied and interesting role from September 2023. The main focus of the role would be to provide support to a year 7 pupil with specific physical needs. You will need to be willing to follow and deliver a bespoke programme of Personal and Intimate Care and physiotherapy and undertake training in manual handling and hoisting. You would also have the opportunity to undertake a small group and in class activities to support the learning of a wide range of pupils with SEND (Special Educational Needs). Many of our Teaching & Learning Assistants have undertaken training opportunities provided and have gone on to careers in teaching.

The hours of work are 28.33 hours per week, term time only (47.15 weeks). Monday to Friday inclusive, 8.20am to 3.00pm. (2 lunch and break covers one week/3 lunch and break covers the following week).

The salary scale for this post is LGA Scale 6 currently £27,852-£29,439 pa, full-time equivalent. The actual pro rata starting salary is £19,336.57 per annum (47.15 weeks per year). There are also opportunities to increase your salary by running lunchtime and homework clubs.
